SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ANNOUNCEMENT.

The Weston-Super-Mare Motor Club Ltd will promote a National B Status Autocross on Sunday, 11th April 2010 on South Beach, Weston Super Mare. OS Map Reference 182/311588.

2. JURISDICTION.

The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. AUTHORISATION.

4. ELIGIBILITY.

The event is open to members of the organising club and the 2010 Richard Egger Southern Autocross Championship contenders, contenders and member clubs of the ASWMC; ACSMC; AWMMC; AEMC and

CMSG

5 All competitors must produce a valid MSA Competition Licence, Club Membership Card and if applicable 2010 Richard Egger Southern Counties Autocross Championship Registration Card.

6. CHAMPIONSHIPS.

The event is a round of the 2010:

Richard Egger Southern Counties Autocross Championship

Weston-Super-Mare Motor Club ALEXANDRE Trophy Championship

Bournemouth & District Car Club Speed Championship

7. EVENT PROGRAMME.

The programme for the event will be as follows;

Scrutineering & Noise Testing commences at 0730 hrs. Individual times for scrutineering will be advised

In the Final Instructions for the event which will be sent to all Entrants/Drivers on Monday 5th April 2010. Practise will commence at approximately 1000 hrs. Any competitor not signed on by 0930 hrs may be excluded.

8. COURSE.

The length of the course will be approximately 1100 metres on a flat hard surface of sand. The course will be defined by white marker poles, which will be at least 1 metre in height, traffic cones, plastic barrels and tyres. Competitors are reminded that if all four wheels go off the course (inside or outside) then you must STOP and not proceed until instructed to do so by an Official. See GR N3.7.7. All red or white marker poles will be penalty markers as defined in N2.4.3.

9. PADDOCK.

Competitors **MUST NOT** practise or warm up their engines by driving at speed in the paddock area. Any

offence will be reported to the Clerk of the Course and may lead to a penalty of exclusion. If any competitors wish to group together in the paddock in order to utilise servicing facilities, this information must be included on their entry forms.

10. FLAGS.

Only one flag will be used in addition to the Union and Chequered flags and that is the RED flag. Drivers **MUST** slow down and STOP immediately to await further instructions from the Course Officials.

11. FUEL

To conform with the Health & Safety Regulations, refuelling of cars must be carried out in controlled conditions from an approved fuel container and with a member of the service/support crew standing by with a primed and ready to use fire extinguisher. There must also be adequate ground cover to prevent spillage onto the sand.

12. CLASSES.

The event will consist of 7 classes as follows:

- A1: Economy Production Saloons up to 1600 cc
- A2: Economy Production Saloons over 1600 cc
- B: Cars up to 1400 cc
- C: Cars over 1400 cc up to 1650 cc
- D: Cars over 1650 cc
- E: Specials and Four Wheel Drive vehicles
- F: Juniors - aged 14 - 17 only.

NOTE: Cars fitted with forced induction will be subject to a 40% capacity loading.
Any motor cycle engined vehicles will be classified as Specials (Class E).

10. Technical Regulations.

- (i) Rally Cars as defined by the MSA Technical Regulations are eligible and are incorporated within classes B,C,D and E only.
- (ii) All competing cars **MUST** comply with Technical Regulations GR J5.1. to J20.13; N4.1 to N4.8.3 & E4.9.2. Cars in classes A1 & A2 **MUST** comply with the current version of N4.9.3 and Class F must comply with N4.21 to N4.21.12. Vehicles not considered, by the Clerk of the Course, to be within the spirit of the regulations for Classes A1 or A2 will not be accepted for entry in these classes.
- (iii) Tyres for this event must comply with GR. N4.14. Hand cut tyres will not be permitted.

11. Awards will be presented for the following:

Fastest Time of Day

1st in Class (Minimum 4 starters)

2nd in Class (Minimum 6 starters)

3rd in Class (Minimum 10 starters)

Best Weston Club Member

Best Lady Competitor (Minimum 3 starters)

Best Newcomer (competing in their first Autocross type event - inc. Sandocross)

Best Team Performance (Minimum of 3 teams)

Best Junior Performance (Minimum 3 starters)

Awards must be collected in person or by an appointed representative; they will not be posted on. 'Best' awards can be won in addition to class performance awards but NOT Fastest Time of Day.

12. ENTRIES. The entry list opens upon publication of these ASR's. **The basic entry fee will be £60** and closing date is Saturday 3rd April. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee; double drives must complete two entry forms. **TWO** stamped addressed envelopes should accompany the entry for **'Finals' and Results. Entries for Teams will be taken on the day of the event at £2 per car per team (£6)**

14. Maximum Entry for this event is 80 and the minimum 40. The minimum for each Class is 4. Should any of these minimum figures not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to either cancel the event or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt with no exceptions. Entry fees will be refunded in full up the closing date, thereafter there will be a £5 administration fee.

16. Provisional Results will be published as soon as possible after the final timed runs and made final as soon as possible after that.

17. Protests. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with GR. C5

18. Starting order will be determined by Class. Cars will start in groups of 4 cars, this being the maximum number of cars on the course at any one time. The start signal will be by lights or the union flag. The method of timing will be electronic starting on the green light. The finish line will be denoted by a chequered flag.

19. Practice. Competitors will have one practise run consisting of 3 laps. There will be a Drivers Briefing prior to the start of practise which is mandatory.

20. Timed Runs. Drivers will have a minimum of 3 timed runs, each of 4 laps duration, time and weather permitting. Fastest time will count in the results of the event.

21. Identification. Competitors will be identified by competition numbers which be allocated by the organisers and will be on sale at Signing-On. Competition numbers must be displayed on both sides of the car and where a car is double driven, the numbers not applicable must be completely covered. If this is not done, the MSA Timekeeper may not give a time and the run will be forfeited. A re-run will not be permitted.

22. Marking and penalties will be in accordance with MSA General Regulation N3.7 to N3.7.7

23. Judges of Fact. Each track marshal will be a Judge of Fact for circuit penalties. A start line judge will be appointed for false starts.

24. Refreshments will be available from the caterer in the Paddock. Please support this facility.

25. Toilets will be on site from Saturday night.

26. Litter. Please take your litter home with you; we want to use this venue again. Any pets must be kept on leads.

27. Final instructions will be posted to all competitors on Tuesday 6th April 2010.
